5. Fill the application (complete all columns carefully)
6. After submission, your Registration Number and Password will be displayed and also sent to you by SMS (to your Mobile phone) and by e-mail.
7. The mobile phone number and e-Mail ID must be accessible by the candidate at all times for receiving further communications related to admission.

# DIPLOMA IN AGRICULTURE AND HORTICULTURE

## I. INTRODUCTION

The Tamil Nadu Agricultural University (TNAU), a global pioneer in agricultural education, research and extension had begun as an Agricultural School at Saidapet in Chennai in 1876 and the exclusive agricultural college was started in Coimbatore, during 1906. In 1920, the college was affiliated to the University of Madras and introduced a three-year degree program. Till 1946, the Agricultural College and Research Institute, Coimbatore was the only institute for agricultural education for the whole of South India. Tamil Nadu Agricultural University was established in 1971. TNAU conducts basic and applied research on different crops in 37 research stations. TNAU spreads knowledge to farmers through 14 Krishi Vigyan Kendras spread all over Tamil Nadu. In the academic year 2017 – 2018, the TNAU will offer the Diploma in Agriculture and Horticulture programs, each of two years (4 semesters) duration, in the following institutes.

## II. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

A pass in the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) or any other examination recognized as equivalent there to and fulfilling the following requirements.

### A. HSC / Equivalent – Academic Stream

Candidates should have studied and passed Physics, Chemistry, Biology (or) Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology in the qualifying examinations.

### B. HSC – Vocational Stream

Candidates who passed HSC under vocational stream and studied Biology and Vocational subject Agricultural Practices (theory and practical) are eligible to apply.

### C. Number of Attempts to Pass

For the purpose of admission to the Diploma courses, the maximum number of attempts to pass qualifying examination is as follows:

### D. Age Limit

Candidates should not have completed the age of 21 years on the first day of July of the admission year (as on 01.07.2017). However, for Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Caste Arunthathiyar/ Scheduled Tribes there is no age limit.

### III. RESERVATIONS

The reservation categories are mutually exclusive and a candidate can opt for only one reservation category though the candidate may be eligible under more than one category. The reservation will be followed as per the orders of the Government of Tamil Nadu in vogue at the time of admission.

\*Tamil Nadu Ordinance No. 4 of 2007 published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Extraordinary No 262 dt. 15.09.2007 provides for reservation in respect of annual permitted strength in each branch or faculty for admission into educational institutions in the State including private educational institutions. For the Backward Class Muslims it shall be three and one-half percent within the thirty percent reservation for Backward Class as provided in the 1994 Act and in 2006 Act.

\*\* G.O. Ms. No. 50, Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare (TD-2) 29.04.2009. (16% seat offered to Arunthathiyars within the seats reserved for scheduled castes for admission in Educational Institutions).

### IV. MODE OF SELECTION

Candidates will be selected on the basis of the marks in their qualifying examination and common ranking procedure with marks as calculated below. **Single window counseling system** is being followed for admission to all diploma programs and for campus allotment.

## V. SYSTEM OF EDUCATION

The system of education is “**Semester Course Credit System**”. An enrolled student in order to earn a diploma should complete the course credits prescribed from time to time and should have earned a minimum Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA) of 6.50 out of 10.00.

## VI. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

English is the medium of instruction in all the constituent and affiliated institutes, except in the Institute of Agriculture at Vamban, where Tamil is the medium of instruction.

## VII. FEES AND DEPOSITS

Candidate should send the application fee (Rs 200/- for General category and Rs. 100/- for SC, SCA and ST category) through a Demand Draft, drawn in favour of “The Dean (Agriculture), Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore-3. At the time of counseling, all provisionally selected candidates will have to pay a non refundable counseling fee of Rs.200/- (Rs.100/- for SC, SCA and ST).

## **X. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR ADMISSIONS**

The candidates shall be required to submit the following documents in **ORIGINAL** at the time of counseling.

- Mark sheet showing the marks obtained in the HSC/Equivalent qualifying examination in each subject.
- Conduct certificate from the Head of the Educational Institution in which the candidate last studied for more than one year.
- Transfer certificate from the Head of the Educational Institution in which the candidate last studied.
- The Original Community- cum-Nativity Certificate issued by the revenue authorities as per **G.O. (Ms). No. 85 BC, MB & MW Department, Dated 29.7.2008, G.O. (Ms). No. 96 BC, MB & MW Department (BCC), Dated 08.9.2008, G.O. (Ms). No. 97 BC, MB & MW Department (BCC), Dated 11.9.2008, G.O. (Ms). No. 37 BC, MB & MW Department (BCC), Dated 21.05.2009 and G.O. (Ms). No.98 BC, MB & MW Department (BCC), Dated 5.11.2009.** An attested photo copy of the same should be enclosed along with application.
- The candidates who have not studied X, XI and XII standards in Tamil Nadu should produce certificate of permanent residence in Tamil Nadu in the prescribed proforma (Certificate appended) from competent authority.
- Joint declaration by the candidate and Parent/Guardian to the effect to abide by the University Rules and Regulations.

**SIGN the application in the space provided. Application without the signature of the candidate and Parent / Guardian will SUMMARILY BE REJECTED.**
