Anent to the ref. cited, It is informed that online registration for reappearance examination July -August 2024 starts **from 01.07.2024 to 10.07.2024** for the on-going batch students (2022, 2021 & 2020 batch) and eligible earlier (2015 to 2019 batch) students. The year coordinators are requested to inform the students and complete the registration before the due date.

Mode of Registration	:	IN PERSON Eligible students of 2022, 2021 and 2020 batches (including along with Junior students) have to complete registration of failed courses only through online for theory alone (or) Practical alone (or) both using Controller of Examinations Web: www.tnau.ac.in under the menu Academics . Click Examinations for reappearance registration. (coe.tnau.ac.in/agriems)
		Eligible students of 2015 to 2019 batches have to complete the registration of failed courses only through offline paper registration in person.
		The minimum credit hours for the registration of reappearance examination is restricted to 25 credits
		Reappearance exam registration done for theory alone/Practical alone/both cannot not be changed . The academic coordinators and principals are requested not to forward the change of registration proposals to the Controller of Examinations

Question Pattern and Marks

The reappearance final theory examinations will be conducted for **60 marks** for courses with practical (1+1, 2+1, 1+2, 2+2) and **100 marks** for courses with Theory-alone (1+0, 2+0, 3+0). The question paper pattern is MCQ in OMR mode.

The reappearance practical examinations will be conducted for **40 marks** for the courses with theory (1+1, 2+1, 1+2, 2+2) and **100 marks** for courses with practical alone (0+1, 0+2).

4. Exam Fees

The reappearance examination fees (Rs.1000/ paper) should be remitted via online (SBI Collect) mode and copy of online payment receipt should be sent to this office along with online registration cards.

General Instructions :

- The candidate has to bring the identity card to the exam hall on the day of exam failing which they will not be allowed to write the examinations.
- The examinations will be conducted through OMR (MCQ's) mode only.
- The candidate has to report to the examination hall at least 30 minutes before the start of examinations.
- No candidate will be allowed to leave the hall till the exam duration is over.
- Any malpractices will be dealt with punishments as per TNAU rules and regulations.
