# PROCEEDINGS OF THE 5<sup>th</sup> SCIENTIST MEET OF AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS AND AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION HELD ON 9.5.2017 and 10.5.2017

Fifth Scientist meet of Agricultural Economics and Agricultural Extension, 2017 was held during 9.5.2017 and 10.05.2017 at TNAU, Coimbatore under the Chairmanship of Dr.K.Ramasamy, Vice-Chancellor, TNAU, Coimbatore.
