The Vice-Chancellor, TNAU, Coimbatore reviewed the activities of ARS, Thirupathisaram on 08.03.2019. Proceedings of the review is communicated for follow up action:

RESEARCH :

1. The mandate of core project for the year 2018-19 should be completed by Dr. G. Preetha, AP (Entomology) from Agricultural College and Research Institute, Killikulam on deputation.
2. The Field demonstration should be conducted in larger area in Farmers field for conformation (OFT) of sheath rot management
3. Local variety Motta kuruva has to be improved as non-lodging type and intensify the regular breeding works.
4. Seed production work has to be increased

GENERAL

1. Although the total area of the farm is 33 acres, only about 10 acres is utilized for cropping. Efforts should be made to fully utilize the available area excepting the pond area for research and seed production.
2. Action to be taken up to popularize the paddy variety TPS 5.
3. License should be obtained for the processing unit for hiring purpose and it should be used for processing TPS 5 in 1st season and TPS 3 in second season. In this regard Director of Seed Certification has to be addressed and a copy marked to Director of Seeds, TNAU, Coimbatore.
4. Old Banana clumps may be uprooted by FRS, Thoivalai and the same may be utilized for planting at FRS, Thoivalai.
5. Planting of Coconut seedlings along one side of the road in the farm premises in addition to the existing palms so as to increase the revenue of the farm.

6. Uprooting and disposal of self-sown suba bul trees along the bunds of farm pond and the areas should be planted with kadamba trees obtained from FC & RI, Mettupalayam as a forage crop.

CIVIL WORKS

1. Estimate should be prepared and submitted for getting approval for lining the irrigation channel in the farm.
2. Explore the possibilities of rectification of existing damaged overhead tank
3. Expedite already approved civil works viz. Labour shed, Tractor shed, Vehicle shed and fence etc.,

Action taken may be reported regularly.
