Submission of Extended Abstracts

Structure of the extended abstract should be composed of title, author(s) with affiliation, introduction, methodology, results, conclusion with figures and references. It should be prepared in Times New Roman, font size 12 with 1.5 spacing, not exceeding 2 pages long. The researchers' are requested to submit their novel research findings adhering the publication ethics. The submitted extended abstracts will be subjected to peer review process and only the accepted abstracts will be published. The name of the presenter should be underlined and asterisk (*) should be indicated for the corresponding author. Preference of presentation should be indicated with # (oral or poster) after affiliation of the author (s). The final decision will be made by the panel members of the Abstract Screening Committee of ICFH2024 after peer reviewing the abstracts.

- Registration of the presenting author is mandatory for including the abstract in the souvenir and the acceptance of the abstract will be intimated through email.
